WHEREAS, on March 23, 2009, the Council of the City of Richmond presented Raymond H. Boone with an official recognition to honor his efforts in implementing the "Love Lights" program; and

WHEREAS, the Council believes that the "Love Lights" program is a benefit for the City by displaying cooperation among businesses and institutions in downtown Richmond and creating a positive impression of the City for citizens and visitors alike; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2009-R187-185, adopted November 23, 2009, the City Council encouraged and supported the "Love Lights" program for the 2009-2010 year; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2010-R182-182, adopted November 22, 2010, Resolution No. 2011-R163-155, adopted November 28, 2011, Resolution No. 2012-R154-152, adopted December 3, 2012, Resolution No. 2013-R253-242, adopted November 25, 2013, and Resolution No. 2014-R237-232, adopted December 8, 2014, the City Council again encouraged and supported the "Love Lights" program for the 2010-2011, 2011-2012, 2012-2013, 2013-2014, and 2014-2015 years, with the display running until January 1 in an effort to conserve energy; and
