ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY

Ordinance to amend and reordain City Code §30-77, which assigns polling places in the city, to relocate the polling places for Precinct 810 from the Southside Community Service Center at 4100 Hull Street to the Celebration Church and Outreach Ministry at 5501 Midlothian Turnpike.

BACKGROUND

This Ordinance is to amend and reordain City Code §30-77, which assigns polling places in the city, to relocate the polling location for Precinct 810 to a newly assigned location.

The Southside Social Services Center currently serves as the polling place for precinct 810. The Department of Social Services notified the City of Richmond Electoral Board that it is likely to discontinue its lease of the Southside Social Services Center which currently serves as a polling place for precinct 810. The proposed ordinance would move the polling place to the Celebration Church and Outreach Ministry, 5501 Midlothian Turnpike. The new facility meets Americans With Disabilities Act requirements and Code of Virginia requirements for polling places.

It is unknown at this time whether this relocation will be temporary or permanent. It is known that the locations will be in place through at least the elections in 2016.

Pursuant to Code of Virginia, §24.2-310 and 24.2-310.1, the City of Richmond polling places for each of the precincts established in this article are listed in the attachment to this Ordinance request.

Fiscal Impact

There will be a small fiscal impact due to having to mail notices of polling place change to the voters of this precinct. The Office of the General Registrar will absorb this cost within existing budgetary resources. For the Celebration Church and Outreach Ministry site, there may be a small fee to rent the facility at approximately \$75.00 per use. This fee will be absorbed by the Office of the General Registrar.

The expected introduction date is October 14, 2015.
