Re: SUP Amendment for 3101 Kensington Avenue

To amend and reordain Ord. No. 2001-262-248, adopted Sep. 10, 2001, which authorized the special use of the property known as 3101 Kensington Avenue for the conversion of the existing building for either 40 or 42 multifamily dwelling units and accessory parking, upon certain terms and conditions, to reflect the subdivision of the property into two parcels, now known as 3101Kensington Avenue and 3131 Kensington Avenue, and to remove the condition that all dwelling units shall be converted to condominiums within five years of the issuance of the certificate of occupancy.

The MDA Zoning & Land Use Committee has met with the applicant, reviewed the amended ordinance, and provided a recommendation to the MDA Board of Directors. After review and consideration, the MDA Board of Directors voted to advise you that we:
