Richmond City Council convened in Informal Session on Monday, April 25, 2016, in the Council Chamber located on the second floor of City Hall, 900 East Broad Street.

Boulevard Development Study and Recommendations

Eric Anthony Johnson, Tripp Umbach representative, provided Council with a preliminary market and impact analysis of the Boulevard site presentation which included public engagement feedback and potential development recommendations. A copy of the presentation has been filed.

Lee Downey, deputy chief administrative officer - Economic and Community Development, was also available to answer questions regarding the possible development of the Boulevard site.

Councilor Parker Agelasto expressed concern that a potential request for proposal (RFP) would not emphasize the explicit construction of a baseball stadium on the Boulevard site even though the public engagement process identified sports and entertainment as a top development strategy.

Councilor Charles Samuels and Vice President Chris Hilbert also expressed the same sentiments as Councilor Agelasto regarding the proposed RFP.

Chief Administrative Officer Selena Cuffee-Glenn reported that community responses from the public engagement meetings supported a wide-range of development strategies and that the completed report would be provided to Council for review.
