They were founded in 1994 as a partnership between the Greater Richmond Chamber of Commerce and the Future of Hampton Roads.

The VHSR has been a continued supporter of advancing the Southeast High Speed Rail (SEHSR) service through Main Street Station. This grant funding will allow for their continued outreach activities as it relates to bringing SEHSR service through Main Street Station.
