To repeal Division 6, in Article III, of Chapter 2, Administration, of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, consisting of Sections 2-166, 2-167, and 2-168, concerning the creation of the Department of Risk Management (2-166), the Director of said Department (2-167) and the duties of said Department (2-168).

1. THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:
2. § 1. That Division 6, in Article III, of Chapter 2
3. of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, consisting of
4. Sections 2-166 through 2-168, inclusive, as follows, be and
5. is hereby repealed:
6. DIVISION 6. DEPARTMENT OF
7. RISK MANAGEMENT
8. Sec. 2-166. Created; composition.
9. There shall be a department of risk management,
10. which shall consist of the director of risk management, and
11. other staff, including but not limited to city safety
12. officer, personnel administrator, purchase and contract
13. manager, departmental safety officer, project coordinator,
14. senior accountant, administrative secretary, administrative

1. clerk and clerk typist II. Provision may be made by
2. ordinance for other employees.

3. Sec. 2-167. Director.

4. The head of the department of risk management shall
5. be the director of risk management. He shall have general
6. management and control of the department, and subject to the
7. provisions of chapter 9 of the Charter, appoint and remove
8. all officers and employees of the department. He shall have
9. power to make rules and regulations consistent with the
10. Charter, this Code and other ordinances of the city for the
11. conduct of its business and shall have such other powers and
12. duties as shall be assigned to him by virtue of the Charter,
13. this article or by ordinance. The director of the
14. department of risk management shall be designated "risk
15. manager."

16. Sec. 2-168. Duties.

17. (a) The department of risk management shall be
18. responsible for the administration and management of the
19. city's insurance program, workmen's compensation, employee
20. hospitalization and the safety and occupational health
21. program of the city.

22. (b) The department of risk management shall work
23. with all departments, division and bureau heads of the city
24. to identify all risks confronting the city; the department

1. shall assist all city department, division and bureau heads
2. to eliminate or reduce risks incidental to the city
3. departments, divisions or bureaus; the department shall
4. develop commercial insurance and self-insurance programs to
5. most effectively and economically protect the city against
6. losses; and the department shall be responsible for the
7. education and training of all city employees with regard to
8. loss prevention and safety technique.
9. § 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect
10. July 1, 1986.
