The purpose of the PAC Work Plan is to further the City’s economic, infrastructural, environmental, and cultural success by judiciously partnering with artists to creatively address City-defined priorities.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

Funding Allocations

- Southside Regional Park & Community Center: from \$175K to \$200K
 - Community Gardens: from \$75K to \$100K
 - Shockoe Bottom: from TBD to \$500K
 - Historic Fulton Memorial Park from \$50K to \$75K
 - Monument Avenue: from \$1M to TBD
 - Westover Hills: from \$25K to \$50K
 - Hillside Court: from \$15K to \$50K
- [total new dollar commitment (sans Monument Ave) = \$975K; leaves \$275K from a total budget of \$125M]
