An avid and active historic preservationist, I am fortunate to have practiced my passion in a variety of capacities. Though I'm now a retired professional, I can't imagine ever growing tired of honoring our built environment and helping others understand and celebrate the unique role that preservation plays in our neighborhoods, economic growth, and community vitality. After decades spent as a marketing and retail copywriter, preservation became my career in 2012. For years, I'd been part of a small group of citizen preservationists in Minneapolis/St. Paul, MN, but I had the opportunity to take volunteering to the next level when I was hired to do marketing and development work for the nonprofit Preservation Alliance of Minnesota (now Rethos). Soon after, I became the organization's first Education Coordinator, where I created and launched the Old Home Certified program. The first of its kind, this 12-credit Continuing Education course for Realtors launched with a multitude of expert-taught,

historic preservation-related classes ranging from “Why Old is Green” to “Old House Vocab.” The program is still going strong, minting hundreds of preservation-wise real estate agents every year. When I moved to Wilmington, NC, in 2016, I continued to work remotely on Old Home Certified, and began volunteering at Legacy Architectural Salvage, the retail arm of the nonprofit Historic W

Richmond’s abundance of built history was the reason my husband and I decided to move here. We specifically chose Church Hill because we wanted to live in a designated City Old & Historic District, and we are now the proud stewards of a brick turn-of-the-century home. It is important to me to be involved in my community; to understand city and neighborhood challenges, and to help in ways that align with my skills and interests. I have always lived in old houses, and I have a deep appreciation for the environmental benefits of preservation, reuse and salvage. Yesteryear’s quality materials ensure that many elements comprising old buildings were designed to be repaired rather than replaced. Also, I am a fervent believer in the economic advantages of adaptive reuse, as evidenced locally in the bustling commercial corridor that is Carytown, residences like the River Lofts at Tobacco Row, and community treasures like the Science Museum of Virginia. Old buildings are often as rich in character as they are in potential, and it would be an honor to help preserve, promote and protect the exceptional historic assets of this city,

Richmonders have great ideas on how to make our city better, and it's my goal to make sure that no Richmonder keeps those ideas to themselves because they feel like their voice won't matter.

Data shows that when citizens participate in and are given direct responsibilities to their self-government, they take it very seriously and generally increase involvement in their communities afterwards. Be it through serving on a jury to determine guilt or innocence, participating in a Citizens' Assembly, or through participatory budgeting, everyday folks rise to the occasion and make decisions that have a higher level of consensus than those typically made through our traditional, more politicized representative bodies.

I'm a passionate believer in the strengthening of our democratic systems and the creation of new ones—more democracy is always better than less democracy. The more people who can affect real, positive change in our self-government, the more legitimacy that self-government has. Democracy is so much more than electing representatives to office, it's everyday citizens learning about a topic, talking to each other, challenging each other, and making decisions about what collective actions to take for the benefit of us all. We're not all always going to agree with each other on a group's ultimate decision, but it's vitally important we create structures and systems where everyday citizens can have their voices heard, feel that their ideas were given a fair shot, and come away feeling that any decisions made were done so fairly.
