



An avid and active historic preservationist, I am fortunate to have practiced my passion in a variety of capacities. Though I'm now a retired professional, I can't imagine ever growing tired of honoring our built environment and helping others understand and celebrate the unique role that preservation plays in our neighborhoods, economic growth, and community vitality.

After decades spent as a marketing and retail copywriter, preservation became my career in 2012. For years, I'd been part of a small group of citizen preservationists in Minneapolis/St. Paul, MN, but I had the opportunity to take volunteering to the next level when I was hired to do marketing and development work for the nonprofit Preservation Alliance of Minnesota (now Rethos). Soon after, I became the organization's first Education Coordinator, where I created and launched the Old Home Certified program. The first of its kind, this 12-credit Continuing Education course for Realtors launched with a multitude of expert-taught,
