Phase 1b **Groups 4–9**

People aged **16 through 64** years with certain conditions or disabilities that increases their risk of severe illness from COVID-19



Due to the national vaccine shortage:

There are not enough doses  
for everyone who is eligible to  
receive them.

The pace of incoming doses is not expected to increase until March, and Virginia is not likely to meet the demand for Phase 1b until March or April.

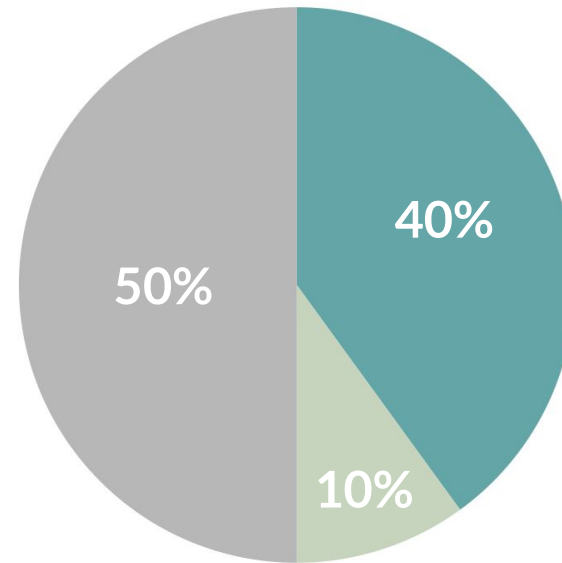

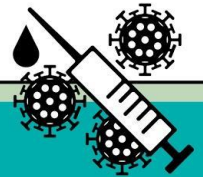
