## 1. THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

2. § 1. That Section 12-280 of the Code of the City of  
 3. Richmond, 1985, be amended and reordained as follows:

4. Sec. 12-280. Police and fire protection; collection and  
 5. disposal of refuse - Real estate exempt  
 6. from taxation.

7. ~~[A fee or service charge, not to exceed forty (40)~~  
 8. ~~percent of the real estate tax rate levied pursuant to~~  
 9. ~~section 6.01 of the Charter which would be applicable to the~~  
 10. ~~real estate for which the city furnishes police and fire~~  
 11. ~~protection and from which it collects and disposes of~~  
 12. ~~refuse, were such real estate not exempt from taxation under~~  
 13. ~~the provisions of section 58.1-3606(1) of the Code of~~  
 14. ~~Virginia, shall be imposed upon and shall be collected from~~  
 15. ~~the owner, or the party in possession of such real estate.]~~

1. For providing police and fire protection and for  
2. collection and disposing of refuse or disposing of refuse  
3. delivered to a facility maintained and operated by the city  
4. for disposition, there is imposed a fee or service charge,  
5. which fee or service charge shall be determined and fixed as  
6. the actual expenditure of the city for providing any or all  
7. of such services, which fee or service charge shall be  
8. collected from the owner or from the party in possession of  
9. the real estate for which such services are provided. Such  
10. service charge shall be fixed by dividing the expenditures  
11. made by the city during the preceding year for such services  
12. by the assessed fair market value of all of the real estate  
13. within the city, including nontaxable property and including  
14. real estate assessed by the state corporation commission,  
15. which fair market value shall be expressed in hundred  
16. dollars.

17. § 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon
