Ordinance No. 2019-313: To amend City Code 2-428, concerning traffic control, for establishing a process of the installation of all-way stop signs.

Impact Statement Summary: This amended Code establishes a process of the installation of all-way stops. This Process is already defined in federal MUTCD and is applicable under State Code in the Commonwealth.

Staff Position: DPW does not support Ordinance No. 2019-313.

Administrative Impact Statement of Ordinance No. 2019-313: The Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) is adopted by reference in accordance with Title 23, United States Code, Section 109(d) and Title 23, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 655.603, and is approved as the national standard for designing, applying, and planning traffic control devices and is applicable to Virginia, pursuant to Va. Code § 46.2-830. The Safe and Healthy Streets Commission of Richmond Virginia adopted by Resolution on January 16, 2019 to follow Federal and State Requirements in the MUTCD.
