1. § 2. That Section 29-288 of the Code of the City of
2. Richmond, 1985, as follows, be and is hereby repealed.

3. Sec. 29-288. Same--Off-street metered parking lots
4. and facilities.

5. (a) No person shall park a motor vehicle in a
6. parking meter space provided in off-street metered parking
7. lots and facilities operated by the city between such hours
8. as may be fixed by regulations promulgated by the director
9. of public safety, unless ten cents (\$0.10) in coin of United
10. States currency shall have been deposited in the parking
11. meter installed at such space for each thirty (30) minutes
12. the vehicle occupies the space, or unless such coin has been
13. previously deposited therein by another for an interval of
14. time which has not expired and the parking meter has been
15. placed in operation. This parking meter rate shall apply to
16. the city owned and operated parking lots in the block
17. bounded by Tenth Street, Broad Street, Eleventh Street and
18. Marshall Street, the upper and lower decks of the Safety-
19. Health-Welfare Building and any other metered lots which may
20. be developed and operated by the city.

21. (b) No person shall permit a motor vehicle under
22. his control to be parked in any such parking metered space
23. during such time limits as may be established by the
24. regulations promulgated by the director of public safety

1. when the parking meter at such space indicates by signal
2. that the lawful parking time at such space has expired,
3. provided, however, the provisions of this section shall not
4. apply during the act of parking or the necessary time which
5. is required for depositing the prescribed coin immediately
6. thereafter.
