
Concept Plan Alternation Option 1







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Park Priorities

The following priorities are recommended based on community feedback. Final construction phasing will be determined by the City of Richmond Parks, Recreation, and Community Facilities (PRCF) based on project costs and available funding.

Construction Prioritization

- 1. Install an electric hookup and push button at the existing concrete water feature.
- 2. Inspect the existing playground for safety and create a plan to maintain, improve, or replace equipment to serve people of all ages.
- 3. PRCF will assess the condition and usability of the existing restroom facility and develop a plan to improve access or upgrade the facility as needed.
- 4. Enhance landscape and shade trees.
- 5. Relocate/Replace storage shed.
- 6. Resurface basketball court and install team benches.
- 7. Update entrance stairs and ramp; install pedestrian plaza and shade sails.
- 8. Update grills and site furnishings; enhance splash pad area.


