




















Map of Byrd Park Court Historic District










Plans for the William Byrd Parkway, an early development in the Carillon Neighborhood, circa 1924.

BUILD BEAUTIFUL ENTRANCE TO WILLIAM BYRD PARKWAY



One side of the new entrance to William Byrd Parkway, nearing completion, showing R. E. Hotze (left) and Field Wilbon, officers of the company, caught on an inspection trip over the premises, where every modern improvement is being installed before the first house is started. The top of the gateway will be surmounted by an eagle and the crest of William Byrd. The tent in the background is the company's field office. A similar gateway is located on the other side of the street, which is parked in the center with a beautiful bed of shrubbery. The Parkway Realty Corporation are constructing sewers, light, gas and other improvement work under specifications and inspection furnished by the city.
