RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND PLANNING COMMISSION

TO ADOPT *RICHMOND INSPIRE: A CITYWIDE VISION PLAN FOR PARKS, RECREATION & COMMUNITY FACILITIES* AS AN AMENDMENT TO THE *RICHMOND 300: A GUIDE FOR GROWTH* MASTER PLAN

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission adopted the *Richmond 300: A Guide for Growth* master plan on 5 October 2020 by Resolution 2020.050; and the City Council approved said master plan by Ordinance No. 2020-236 on 14 December 2020; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with § 17.06 of the City Charter, the City Planning Commission may adopt, and the City Council may approve, from time to time, amendments, extensions, or additions to said master plan; and

WHEREAS, *Richmond 300: A Guide for Growth* calls for the creation of a new parks master plan to create a transparent, community-driven vision for parks and recreation; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities engaged the community over the course of over two years to create *Richmond INSPIRE: A Citywide Vision Plan for Parks, Recreation & Community Facilities* as the parks master plan, by attending public meetings, engaging thousands of community members in-person, and by collecting thousands of surveys and comments; and

WHEREAS, the Advisory Board for Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities provided a letter of support for *Richmond INSPIRE*; and

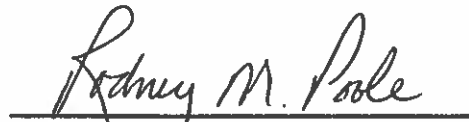
WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission conducted a public hearing concerning amendment of the *Richmond 300: A Guide for Growth* master plan by adoption of the *Richmond INSPIRE: A Citywide Vision Plan for Parks, Recreation & Community Facilities* on 16 June 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission has reviewed the *Richmond INSPIRE: A Citywide Vision Plan for Parks, Recreation & Community Facilities* and taken into consideration public comments; and

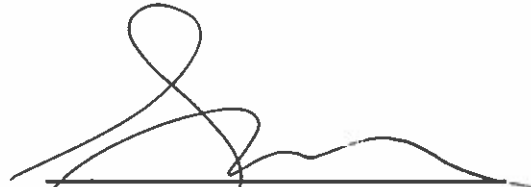
