Ethics Reform Commission

Vacancies as of August 13, 2023

Ordinance No. 2019-264, adopted November 12, 2019, established the Ethics Reform Commission of the City of Richmond with indefinite duration for the purpose of providing to the Council and the Mayor information and advice concerning the implementation of the recommendations from the Ethics Reform Task Force.

The Richmond City Council Ethics Reform Commission shall be composed of **eleven members** whom the Council and the Mayor shall appoint. Of the eleven members, the **Council shall nominate nine members** and the **Mayor shall nominate two members**.

Members should be **broadly representative of each of the City's nine Council districts** and have experience and expertise in ethics rules and regulations in the government or private sector, procurement, human resources, related legal issues, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), and other code of ethics areas.



- (e) Four persons who, at the time of appointment, reside in a City Council district within the city of Richmond with a poverty rate of at least 20%. At least one of the four persons shall, at the time of appointment, be a tenant of the Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority or a recipient of Section 8 housing vouchers from the Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority;
- (f) A business owner or a representative of a business with a workforce made up of employees, the majority of whom reside in the city of Richmond;
- (g) A representative of a college or university located within the city of Richmond with expertise in studying poverty or in program evaluation;
- (h) A person who resides within the city of Richmond;
- (i) A member of the City Council, who shall be a non-voting member of the board and shall serve as co-chair.



Of the twelve members, the City Council shall appoint seven members, including the members designated in subdivisions (1) through (4) and (9-11). The mayor, by a writing submitted to the City Clerk, shall appoint four members designated in subdivisions (5) through (8) and (12).
