DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

The following ordinance was considered:

1. ORD. To erect two additional stop signs at the intersection of Nottoway Avenue and Fauquier Avenue for the purpose of making the intersection an all-way stop. (3rd District)

Patrons: Ms. Lambert

Chair Andreas Addison inquired about the possibility of including maps with the ordinances that site specific areas as part of the agenda packet used in each Land Use, Housing and Transportation Standing Committee meeting.

Steven Taylor, Council Policy Analyst, introduced the proposed ordinance, and stated that the installation of a 4-way stop had been requested through petition by local residents.

Public Hearing

Kelly Martin stated his support of proposed ORD. 2023-145, and he elaborated his reasoning for the installation of a 4-way stop. Specifically, Mr. Martin spoke of the safety concerns neighborhood residents had regarding the intersection.

Vice Chair Ellen Robertson questioned the impact of Council's traffic calming decisions, specifically decisions made in opposition to city administration's recommendations. Vice Chair Robertson requested information regarding the impact of a 4-way stop sign installed at the suggested location in proposed ORD. 2023-145.

Chair Addison questioned the impact and the necessity of a 4-way stop installed at the location suggested in the proposed ordinance. Chair Addison also requested more research regarding the impact of the proposed 4-way stop.

Sharon Ebert, Deputy Chief Administrative Officer (DCAO) for Planning and Economic Development, provided the committee with comments from the Department of Public Works concerning the proposed ordinance. DCAO Ebert stated that an engineering traffic study was highly reccomended in order to determine the safest traffic pattern for the intersection.

There were no further comments or discussions and Vice Chair Ellen Robertson moved to forward ORD. 2023-145 to Council with recommendation to approve, which was seconded and unanimously approved.

2. ORD. To designate the 5100 block of Beddington Road in honor of the late Raymond H. Boone and Jean P. Boone. (8th District)
