

AN ORDINANCE No 86-182-172

ADOPTED JUL 14 1986

To amend and reordain § 5 of Article III, Compensation of Officers and Employees, of Ordinance No. 86-119-148, adopted May 28, 1986, effective September 27, 1986, adopting a pay plan for the classes of positions in the classified service of the City government and fixing the compensation of the officers and employees in the unclassified service, so as to fix the compensation of the City Manager.

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

1. That § 5 of Article III of Ordinance No. 86-119-148, adopted May 28, 1986, effective September 27, 1986, be and is hereby amended and reordained as follows:

§ 5. The City Manager shall receive a salary of \$110,000.00 per annum.

~~[Effective-July-17-1984]~~ The pay of the City Manager ~~[may]~~ shall be supplemented in the amount of ~~[five-per-cent (5%) of the sum set out in the foregoing sentence]~~ \$7,500 per annum pursuant to execution by the City Manager of a participation agreement, ~~[ex-by-amendment-of-a-previously executed-agreement]~~ which agreement conforms to the applicable Internal Revenue Code provisions and regulations and Article III, Chapter 23, Deferred Compensation Plan, of

the Richmond City Code of [~~1975~~] 1985, by a payment or payments made to a deferred compensation plan of the City of Richmond.

In addition, the City Manager shall receive the sum of \$450 per month as an automobile expense allowance and, so long as necessary during the first six months of his employment by the City of Richmond, the City Manager shall receive an amount not greater than \$600 per month as a temporary living allowance; provided, however, the temporary living allowance may be extended for an additional period of not to exceed six months with the approval of Council's Agencies Committee.

2. This ordinance shall be in force upon adoption and effect as of September 27, 1986.
