- 1 - nominated by the Board of Directors of the Maymont Foundation to represent the foundation, and
- 1 - nominated by the Board of Directors of the EnRichmond Foundation to represent the foundation.
- 1 - staff of the city's Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities.
- 9 - selected from each of the nine Councilmanic Districts of the City, with each such member to be a resident of the Councilmanic District

*** Should the Council member representing such Councilmanic District fail to nominate a resident of the Councilmanic District within 90 days of a vacancy, whether created by the expiration of a term or otherwise, in the seat assigned to that Councilmanic District, any Council member may nominate a resident of any Councilmanic District to fill such vacancy.*

The Commission shall consist of the following members as set forth in section 2.2-5205 of the Code of Virginia, (1950), as amended:

- Director of Social Services
- Chief Executive Officer of the Richmond Behavioral Health Authority
- Director of Thirteenth District Court Services Unit
- Director of the Richmond City Health District
- Director of Justice Services
- Superintendent of Public Schools
- A parent representative who receives or has received services for the representative’s child or foster child through one or more of the agencies participating in the Community Policy and Management Team.
- A representative of a private organization located within the City that (i) serves children and families in the City, (ii) has a provider contract with the City’s Comprehensive Services Act office, (iii) is in compliance with its provider contract and (iv) is properly licensed by the Commonwealth as a provider of services to children and families. If this representative’s organization fails to remain in good standing pursuant to its contract with the City’s Comprehensive Services Act office, then the representative’s seat on the team will become vacant immediately upon the occurrence of such failure, and the Council will appoint a new representative from a different eligible organization.
- An elected official or an appointed official or the designee thereof from the City Council.
