PURPOSE: To amend and reordain the fees set forth in Appendix A of the City Code for sections 42-141(v) of the City Code, concerning rates and discounts for parking facilities operated by the City. 27. Ord. No. 2015-77 which will increase the Parking Enterprise Fund's anticipated revenues and appropriations by \$207,000.

REASON: To amend the Parking Enterprise Fund due to the operation of the Gateway Garage. The City of Richmond will operate the new Gateway Building parking facility located at 800 E. Canal Street beginning in Fiscal Year 2016.

RECOMMENDATION: The adoption of this ordinance is recommended by the Department of Public Works.

BACKGROUND: The City of Richmond will operate the new Gateway Building parking facility located at 800 E. Canal Street beginning in Fiscal Year 2016. The parking facility consists of 506 parking spaces with 300 available for public use.

§ 1. That Chapter 42, Article IV of the Code of the City of Richmond (2004) be and is hereby amended and reordained by adding therein a new section 42-141 as follows:

Sec. 42-141. Rates and discounts for parking facilities operated by the City. The rates and discounts for parking in the following City-owned off-street parking facilities shall be as set forth in Appendix A to this Code:

(v) Gateway Garage at 800 E. Canal Street

§ 2. That Appendix A to the Code of the City of Richmond (2004) be and is hereby amended and reordained by adding therein a new fee for section 42-141 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2004) as follows:
