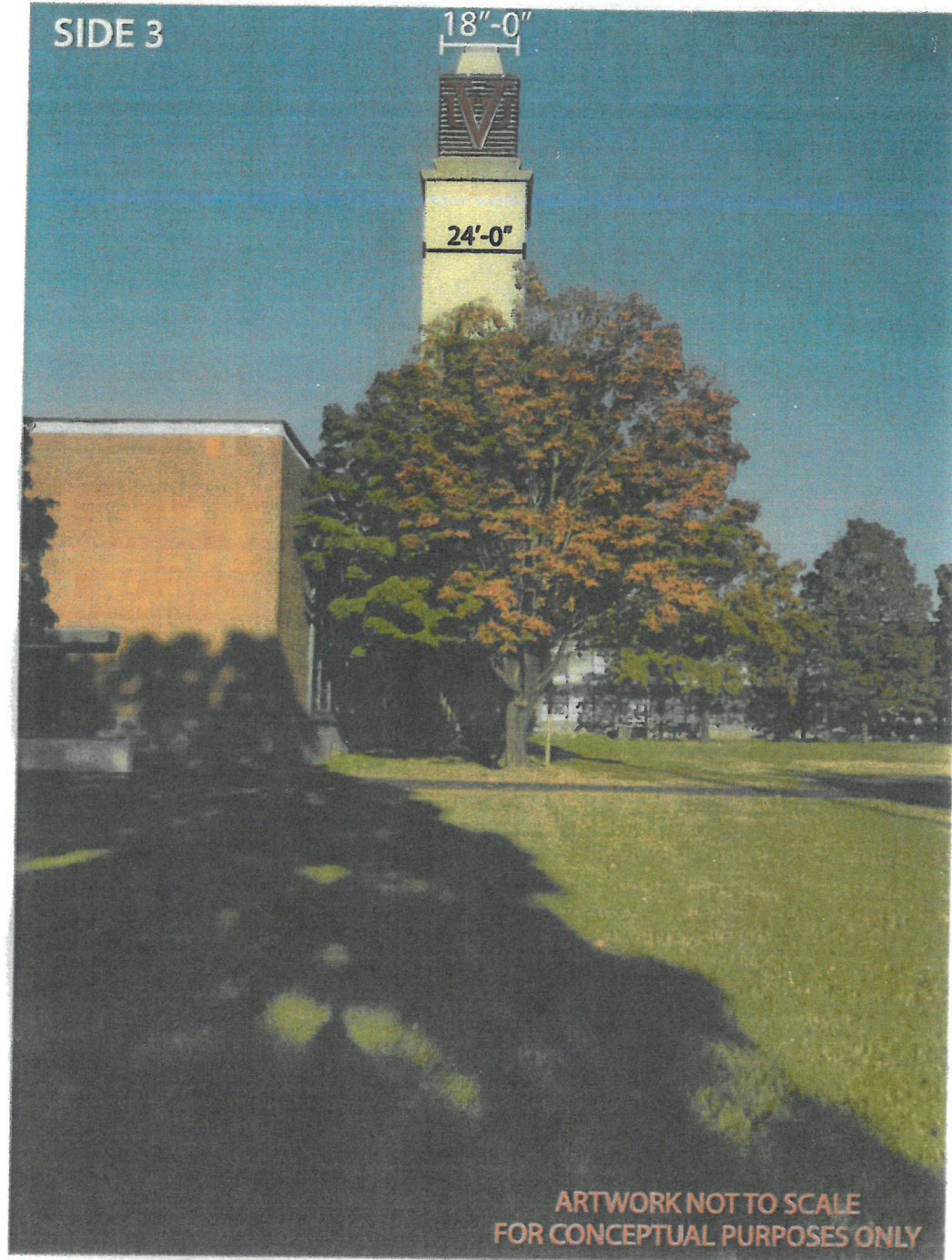

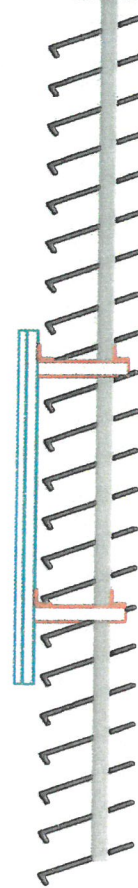


5" FROM BACK OF LETTER TO FRONT OF LOUVER

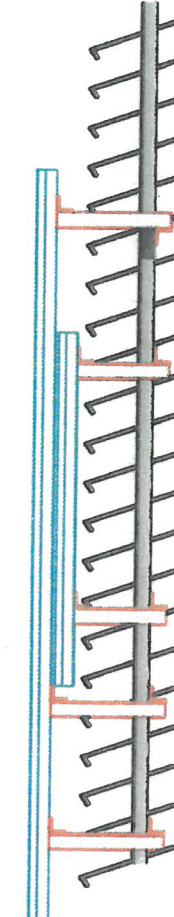


END VIEW "V" LETTER SECTION ONLY
