To authorize Richmond Newspapers, Inc., to use the Dogwood Dell, the Carillon and the Carillon Grounds for its annual Patriotism Day Festival and to authorize the sale of crafts, goods, food and non-alcoholic beverages on September 6, 1986.

1. THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:
2.           § 1. The provisions of Article VIII of Chapter 9
3. of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, and any other
4. applicable provisions of law of the City to the contrary
5. notwithstanding, Richmond Newspapers, Inc., may use Dogwood
6. Dell, the Carillon and the Carillon Grounds for its annual
7. Patriotism Day Festival on September 6, 1986. In connection
8. therewith crafts, goods, food and non-alcoholic beverages
9. may be sold. An area shall be designated by the City and
10. Richmond Newspapers, Inc., for an authentic reenactment of a
11. Revolutionary encampment. For security purposes persons
12. authorized by Richmond Newspapers, Inc., may spend the night
13. before the festival in the park to secure same. Richmond
14. Newspapers, Inc., shall provide general liability insurance,
15. with the City of Richmond named as an additional insured, in

1. an amount of \$1,000,000 and shall pay all fees due the City  
2. for such use of Dogwood Dell, the Carillon and the Carillon  
3. grounds.

4. § 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect at  
5. 6:00 a.m. on September 5, 1986, and shall continue in  
6. force until midnight on September 6, 1986.
