Key Moments:

Record-Breaking Participation

Enrollment surged to 3,581 readers, a 52.6% increase from 2023. Most youth participation in Summer Reading ever!

Expanded Youth Programming

Offered dramatically more story times, STEAM programs, and workshops across all nine library locations

Intern Power

Paid Summer Interns increased from 2 to 10 so there was more of everything for RVA families.
