No. 2014-61-98, adopted May 27, 2014, which (i) accepted a program of proposed Capital Improvement Projects for Fiscal Year 2014-2015 and the four fiscal years thereafter, (ii) adopted a Capital Budget for Fiscal Year 2014-2015, and (iii) determined a means of financing the same, to modify the purpose of the Meadow & Harrison Paving project in the Transportation category to provide that such project consists of the asphalt restoration of Meadow Street and Harrison Streets and the repaving of other streets in the Meadow and Harrison Uptown Neighborhood, including, but not limited to, South Allen Avenue, Randolph Street, Temple Street.

PURPOSE

To modify the Meadow & Harrison Paving project in the Transportation category of the Capital Budget to provide that such project consists of the asphalt restoration of Meadow Street and Harrison Streets and the repaving of other streets in the Meadow and Harrison Uptown Neighborhood, including, but not limited to, South Allen Avenue, Randolph Street, Temple Street

SUMMARY & RECOMMENDATION

City Council added funds to the FY2014 Capital Budget for FY2015 for \$268,780 for the Meadow & Harrison street Paving Project. While City Council also adopted that project for the same amount in the FY2015 Capital Budget, the project description and scope of the Meadow & Harrison Paving Project was incorrect in the adopted Capital Budget documents. This paper will amend the project description and Scope for the purpose that was originally intended. Staff recommends approval of the proposed amendment to the Capital Budget.
