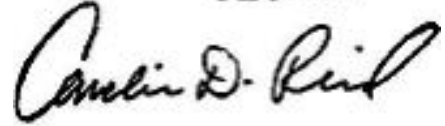

ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY

The patron request that a resolution be drafted for Council’s consideration that supports studies to designates the Jackson Ward area as a design overlay district.

Council request that the CAO cause all necessary public hearings and studies be drafted to govern a design overlay district in order to protect and enhance the character of the area by regulating development, new construction, building alterations, rehabilitations, and demolitions of structures in the area.

For purposes of this legislation Jackson area located within North Belvedere Street (east), Interstates 64 and 95 (north), North 3rd Street (west), and the alley between West Marshall Street and West Broad Street (south).

BACKGROUND

The City has made certain designations of overlay districts to protect the architectural character of neighborhoods. Residents and business located in Jackson Ward have expressed their desires to protect of the character of that neighborhood and its history with a design overlay district codification.

There have been previous studies conducted by VCU's Urban Planning Program (Jackson Ward Neighborhood Plan), Richmond 300, and community meetings and discussions to preserve and publicize the history of Jackson Ward.
