Appropriating and providing funds for rebuilding, replacing, expanding, and renewing the Coliseum structure and fixed assets necessary for its operation for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1985, and ending June 30, 1986.

1. THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:
2. § 1. That pursuant to the provisions of Section
3. 6.15:1, "Coliseum Renewal Fund", of the Charter of the City
4. of Richmond, a sum not exceeding \$230,500, including the sum
5. of \$100,000 appropriated in the 1984-1985 General Fund
6. Budget of the City to the Coliseum to offset operating
7. deficit, recommended by the City Manager to be transferred
8. to the "Coliseum Renewal Fund", same being the estimated
9. receipts authorized in said Charter provision to be paid
10. into the "Coliseum Renewal Fund", be and is hereby appro-
11. priated from the said "Coliseum Renewal Fund" for the
12. purpose of rebuilding, replacing, expanding, and renewing
13. the Coliseum structure and fixed assets necessary for the
14. operation of the Coliseum; provided, however, that any

1. expenditure herein authorized shall be subject to availa-
2. bility of the funds herein appropriated. The funds are
3. appropriated for the following projects and the estimated
4. cost of each project is as follows:

5.	1. Exterior Lighting Project/Mid-Level	\$50,000
6.	2. Exterior Lighting Project/Upper-Level	43,500
7.	3. Design and Modification of Rigging System	15,000
8.	4. Purchase Industrial Sweeper/Scrubber	20,000
9.	5. Purchase Pick-up Truck	9,000
10.	6. Purchase Black Plastic Dividing Drape	17,000
11.	7. Replace Exterior Windows and Skylights	13,000
12.	8. Building Renovations and Repairs	35,000
13.	9. Purchase Computer and Word Processor	12,000
14.	10. Purchase Floor Exhibit Drapes and Crossbars	3,500
15.	11. Purchase Box Office Alarm	3,000
16.	12. Purchase Safeway Stage Units	4,000
17.	13. Establish Clay Street Tunnel Storage Area	5,500

18. § 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon
19. adoption, and shall constitute the "Coliseum Renewal Fund"
20. appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year commencing on
21. July 1, 1985, and ending on June 30, 1986.

I recommend that \$100,000 appropriated in the 1984-1985 General Fund Budget to the Coliseum in order to defray the anticipated operating deficit of the Coliseum be transferred to the "Coliseum Renewal Fund" and that the sum of \$230,500 of estimated receipts (revenue) of the "Coliseum Renewal Fund" be appropriated in the manner and for the purposes set out in the foregoing ordinance.
