Transferring \$25,000 of the unencumbered balance of funds in "Reserve for Contingencies", appropriated in the General Fund Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the fiscal year 1986-1987 (Ordinance No. 86-118-142, adopted May 28, 1986) to the Appropriation, Non-Departmental, Payments to Other Governmental Agencies, to Chesterfield County for the City sharing in funding Henricus Historical Park, located on the James River at Dutch Gap, of great significance in the history of the Richmond Metropolitan Area and the Virginia colonies which later became the Commonwealth of Virginia (General Fund Budget, pages 33-1 and 33-2).

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the sum of \$25,000 is hereby transferred from the unencumbered balance of funds in "Reserve for Contingencies", appropriated in the General Fund Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the fiscal year 1986-1987 (Ordinance No. 86-118-142, adopted May 28, 1986) to the Appropriation, Non-Departmental, Payments to Other Governmental Agencies, to Chesterfield County for the City sharing in funding Henricus Historical Park, located on the James River at Dutch Gap, of great significance in the history of the Richmond Metropolitan Area and the Virginia colonies which later became the Commonwealth of Virginia (General

Fund Budget, pages 33-1 and 33-2), such transfer having been recommended by the City Manager and the Director of Finance having certified that there is a sum not heretofore allotted for a specific purpose in the appropriation made to Reserve for Contingencies sufficient to meet this transfer of appropriation.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.

I recommend that this transfer in the amount of \$25,000 be made to the Appropriation, Non-Departmental, Payments to Other Governmental Agencies.
