Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments on the review of ADA accessibility improvements at Pump House Park. We are writing in support of these improvements. We at Historic Richmond have been working closely over the past year with the Friends of the Pump House and the Department of Parks and Recreation on a preservation project focused on roof repairs, repairs to facilitate better use of the open air social pavilion and accessibility. These ADA accessibility improvements are a critical step needed for the ultimate completion of this project and are included in the Pump House Park Master Plan, completed by Timmons Group and 3North in July 2019, and the James River Park System Master Plan, adopted in January 2020. Additionally, these improvements will facilitate greater access for diverse visitors to and through the James River Parks System and the James River.
