Sheriff's fleet vehicles with camera equipment.

PURPOSE: Authorizing the City Administration to accept the award from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs grant in the amount of Seventy Thousand (\$75,000.00) dollars and appropriating the increase to Special Fund (01601 Cost Center) for the Richmond City Sheriff's Office (RCSO). There is also a \$25,000.00 match.

REASON: The Richmond City Sheriff's Office seeks approval for funds in the amount of \$75,000.00 awarded by the Department of Criminal Justice Services' Byrne Justice Assistance Grant Award with a Cash Match of \$25,000.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that this funding be accepted and appropriated to the Richmond City Sheriff's Office effective Fiscal Year 2025.

BACKGROUND: The Richmond City Sheriff's Office (RCSO) currently does not have a camera system in their fleet vehicles. The RCSO has 81 fleet vehicles and is looking to outfit 22-25 vehicles with camera equipment to provide accountability, safety, and transparency, following the agency's internal Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs).

FISCAL IMPACT / COST: These funds will increase the Special Funds Budget.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS: The acceptance of funds (\$75,000.00 with Cash Match of \$25,000.00) will allow the Richmond City Sheriff's Office to outfit 22-25 vehicles with camera equipment to provide accountability, safety, and transparency, following the agency's internal SOPs.

BUDGET AMENDMENT NECESSARY: Yes, the FY 2025 Special Funds Budget will need to be amended.

REVENUE TO CITY: The City of Richmond will add \$100,000 (\$75,000.00 from Grant Funds and \$25,000.00 transferred as cash match from General Funds) as a Byrne-JAG Federal Grant through the Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS).
