

AN ORDINANCE No. 87-77-102

To repeal Section 12-268 of the Code of the City of Richmond 1985, concerning fees to be charged for use of tennis courts in Westover, Battery Park and Byrd Park.

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That Section 12-268 of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, as follows, be and is hereby repealed:

Sec. 12-268. Tennis courts; Westover, Battery Park and Byrd Park.

(a) A fee of one dollar (\$1.00) shall be charged and paid into the city treasury by each adult (any person eighteen (18) years of age or older) for the use of any tennis court (that is subject to being reserved for use) at the Westover, Battery Park and Byrd Park tennis courts for each hour and a half (1-1/2 hours) of play (i.e., playing time).

(b) Upon payment of an annual membership fee of fifty (\$50.00) dollars, any adult (as defined above) shall be entitled to reserve one tennis court at Westover, Battery Park, or Byrd Park, which court is subject to reservation per day for a period not to exceed one and one-half (1-1/2)

hours and to use such reserved court without being required to pay the one dollar (\$1.00) fee per hour and a half use of the court herein imposed. Any additional reservation on the same day shall require payment of the regular dollar fee for one and one-half (1-1/2) hour usage of the court so reserved.

(c) Use of courts for tournament play shall be subject to payment of the fee fixed in Section 12-267.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect July 1, 1987.
