To approve the display of the City's banners commemorating the first anniversary of the opening of the Sixth Street Marketplace, in the public right of way within the area generally bounded by 4th, Grace, 9th and Clay Streets, upon certain terms and conditions.

1 WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of Richmond have
2 displayed banners in greatly increasing numbers in recent years,
3 marking major events in their lives or simply contributing to
4 the aesthetic enjoyment of their neighborhoods; and

5 WHEREAS, the citizens of Richmond have thereby begun
6 what is sure to be a long-standing tradition, making the City of
7 Richmond even more so a "banner city"; and

8 WHEREAS, the administration of the City of Richmond
9 has proposed joining in the tradition of banner display in order
10 to mark a major event in the life of the City -- the first
11 anniversary of the opening of the Sixth Street Marketplace on
12 September 18, 1985; and

13 WHEREAS, the Sixth Street Marketplace is an historic
14 public and private venture, at the heart of the City's efforts
15 to revitalize its downtown area; and

1 WHEREAS, as part of its observance of the first
2 anniversary of the opening of the Marketplace, Richmond
3 Renaissance, Inc. has offered a gift to the City of numerous
4 banners, designed and made to City specifications and intended
5 to contribute to the festive spirit of the City's celebration of
6 the event, which gift has now been most gratefully accepted; and

7 WHEREAS, the approval of the Council is required for a
8 special display of the banners; and

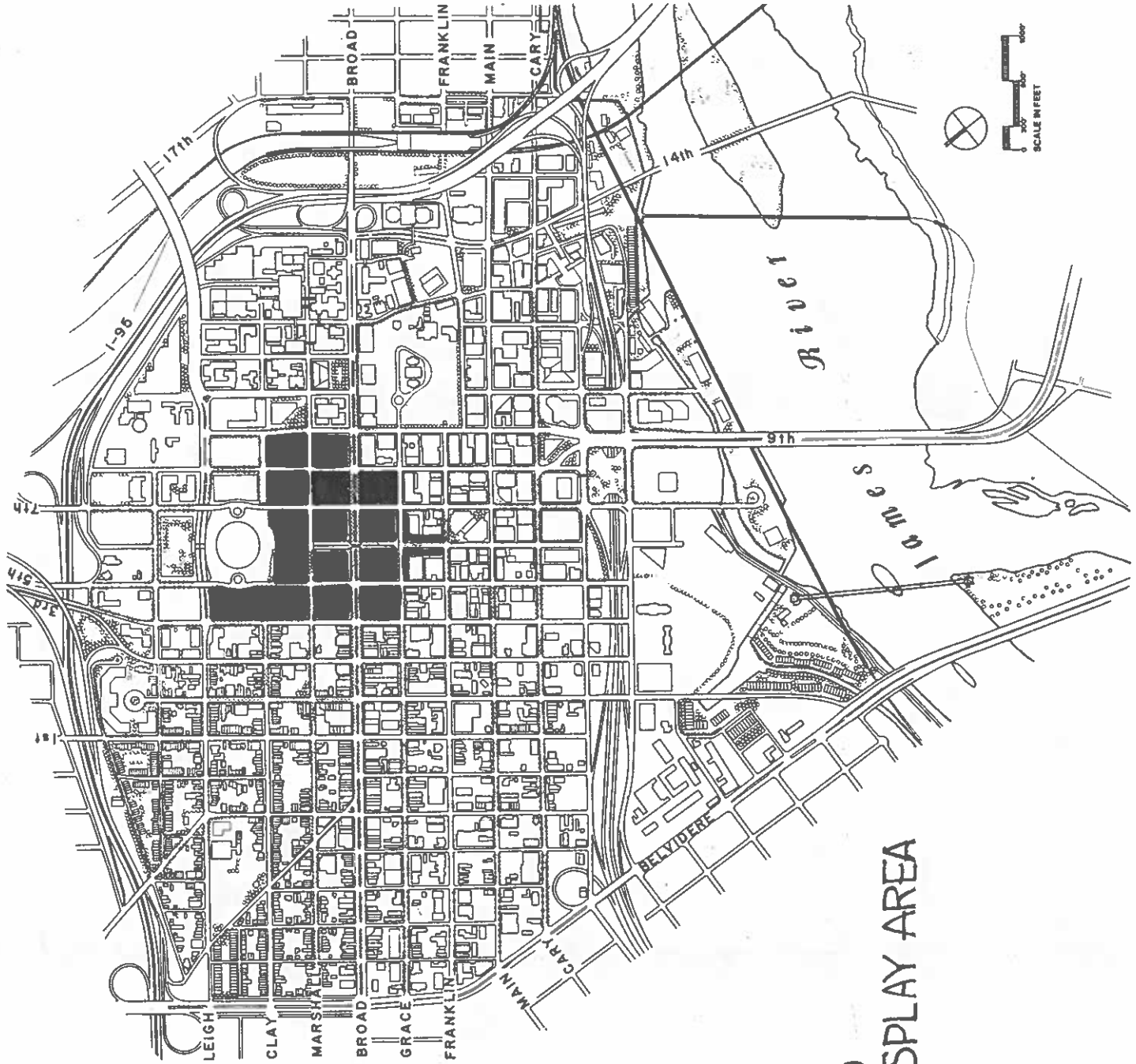
9 WHEREAS, The Council finds that the display of the
10 City's banners to celebrate an event of great significance to
11 the City of Richmond as a whole is entirely fitting and proper;

12 NOW, THEREFORE,

13 THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

14 § 1. That display of the City's banners commemorating
15 the first anniversary of the opening of the Sixth Street
16 Marketplace is hereby approved, in accordance with Section
17 3-42(a)(6) of the Code of the City of Richmond (1986 Supp.).
18 Such banners shall be displayed only in the public right of way
19 within the area generally bounded by 4th, Grace, 9th and Clay
20 Streets, as shown on the attached drawing entitled: "Proposed
21 Banner Display Area", the particular locations within such
22 boundaries to be determined by the city manager or his
23 designee. The city manager or his designee shall permit the
24 continued display of the banners for a reasonable time as may be
25 in keeping with the significance of the occasion. Any banner

1 displayed shall be and remain in conformity with the original
2 City specifications established concerning size, quality of
3 materials, and content.

SUMMARY

This Ordinance would approve the display of the City's banners commemorating the First Anniversary of the opening of the Sixth Street marketplace, in the public right-of-way within the area generally bounded by 4th, Grace, 9th and Clay Streets.

The banners would represent a demonstration program that may be expanded in the future as part of an overall effort to enhance the downtown area and create a more festival atmosphere.

The banners, measuring 2'X8', would be installed in pairs on existing street light pole, with two 2 such installations per block.

They would contain graphic symbols of major downtown attractions in coordinated color shames.
