

AN ORDINANCE No. 87-52-56

To amend and reordain Section 16-2 of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, as amended, concerning the creation of old and historic districts and the boundaries of such districts, to amend the boundaries of the district known as "St. John's Church Old and Historic District".

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That Section 16-2 of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, be amended and reordained as follows:

Sec. 16-2. Districts created; boundaries of districts.

In order to execute the purposes and objectives declared in section 16-1 of this code and pursuant to the powers granted to and conferred upon the city in section 15.1-503.2 of the Code of Virginia and section 17.10 of the Charter, there is hereby created in the city and it is hereby divided into certain districts to be known as "Old and Historic Districts", which are hereinafter referred to as such in this chapter, and which shall be in addition to the districts into which the city is divided by chapter 32 of this code. The boundaries of such districts are as follows:

St. John's Church Old and Historic District

The St. John's Church Old and Historic District shall consist of the area beginning at the point of intersection of the east line of Twenty-Second Street with the north line of East Franklin Street, thence extending along the north line of East Franklin Street to the east line of Twenty-First Street, thence extending along the east line of Twenty-First Street to the south line of an eighteen foot east-west alley between Broad Street and Marshall Street; thence extending along the south line of said alley to the east line of a fifteen foot north-south alley between Twenty-First Street and Twenty-Second Street, thence extending along the east line of said alley to the south line of a fifteen foot alley between Broad Street and Marshall Street, thence extending along the south line of said alley to the west line of Twenty-Second Street, thence extending across Twenty-Second Street to the north line of the alley between Broad Street and Marshall Street, thence extending along the north line of the alley to the west line of Twenty-Third Street, thence extending along the west line of Twenty-Third Street to the south line of Marshall Street, thence extending along the south line of Marshall Street to the west line of Twenty-Fifth Street, thence extending along the west line of Twenty-Fifth Street to a point midway

between Broad Street and Marshall Street, thence extending along a line parallel with Broad Street to the west line of ~~[Thirty-Second-Street-at-the-intersection-with-the-south line-of-the-alley-between-Marshall-Street-and-Broad-Street; thence-southerly-along-the-west-line-of-Thirty-Second-Street to-the-north-line-of-Grace-Street;]~~ Twenty-Ninth Street at a point midway between Marshall Street and Broad Street; thence northerly along the west line of Twenty-Ninth Street to the south line of Marshall Street; thence in an easterly direction along the south line of Marshall Street to the east line of Thirty-First Street; thence northerly along the east line of Thirty-First Street to the south line of a 15.61 foot east-west alley between Marshall Street and Clay Street; thence along the south line of the alley to the west line of Thirty-Second Street; thence southerly along the west line of Thirty-Second Street to the north line of Grace Street; thence in a southeasterly direction along the westerly edge of the roadway in Chimborazo Park a distance of 400 feet, more or less, thence in a southwesterly direction a distance of 700 feet, more or less, to the intersection of the south line of Libby Terrace and the west line of Thirty-First Street, thence along Thirty-First Street in a southerly direction to the north line of Williamsburg Avenue, thence in a westerly direction along

the north line of Williamsburg Avenue to an intersection with Main Street, thence in a northwesterly direction along Main Street to a point approximately 140 feet east of Twenty-Seventh Street, thence northwardly along a line parallel to Twenty-Seventh Street to a point midway between Franklin Street and Main Street, thence extending along a line parallel with the south line of Franklin Street to the east line of Twenty-Second Street, thence extending along the east line of Twenty-Second Street to the point of beginning.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.

SUMMARY
