THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That section 13-195 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015) be and is hereby **amended** and reordained as follows:

**Sec. 13-195. Storage of tires.**

It shall be unlawful to store, outside of a completely enclosed building or structure, any [~~used~~] rubber tires, including automobile, truck and similar rubber tires, or scrap tires, tire pieces or combustible byproducts. This section shall not apply to the storage of up to four rubber tires for personal use.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
