

AN ORDINANCE No. 87-86-111
ADOPTED MAY 28 1987

Adopting the Gas Utility Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1987, and ending June 30, 1988, and appropriating the estimated receipts of the Gas Utility for the said fiscal year and making an appropriation from the Gas Utility Renewal fund for renewing, rebuilding or extending the plant and distribution system of the gas utility.

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the budget designated the Gas Utility Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1987, and ending June 30, 1988, bound with the draft of the general fund budget, a copy of which is attached to the draft of the general fund budget ordinance, is hereby adopted and made a part of this ordinance.

§ 2. That the sum of \$65,304,300 be and is hereby appropriated from the estimated receipts of the gas utility for the fiscal year 1987-1988 for salaries, wages and other expenses, necessary for Gas Production, Distribution, Customer Field Service, Design, Supply and Marketing, Customer Service and Administration of the Gas Utility as set forth in the Gas Utility Budget.

§ 3. That the sum of \$217,877 be and is hereby appropriated from the gas utility renewal fund for renewing, rebuilding and extending the utility as set forth in the Utility Budget, the said appropriation having been recommended by the City Manager.

§ 4. That the payment and settlement of claims of any kind heretofore or hereafter asserted against the City growing out of the operation of the gas utility and final judgments heretofore or hereafter asserted against the City on account thereof, together with all costs, interest, fees for legal services and all other fees and expenses incident thereto, and all fees, costs and other expenses incurred in providing legal and other services authorized by Section 2-37.10 of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, shall be paid upon the approval and order of the City Attorney from the funds herein appropriated for defraying the expense of operating the gas utility; except that in the case of judgments against the City, payment thereof shall be limited to the extent of funds available in the appropriation for the purpose.

§ 5. This ordinance shall be in force and effect at the first moment of the first day of July 1987, and shall constitute the gas utility appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year commencing on that date.
