To approve the display of the City's banners commemorating the upcoming holiday season, in the public right of way along Cary Street, between Thompson Street and the Boulevard, upon certain terms and conditions.

WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of Richmond have established a long-standing tradition of banner display, and in the process have made Richmond the "City of Banners"; and

WHEREAS, the Council and the administration of the City of Richmond are desirous of displaying banners on a regular basis, thereby promoting both the City and the tradition of banner display; and

WHEREAS, in anticipation of the upcoming holiday season - a time of celebration for the City as a whole - Carytown, Inc., has offered a gift to the City of numerous banners of a design and construction acceptable to the City administration, and intended to contribute to the festive spirit of the City's observance of the holiday season, which gift has now been most gratefully accepted; and

WHEREAS, the approval of the Council is required for a special display of the City's banners; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that the display of the City's banners in observance of the holiday season is entirely fitting and proper; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That display of the City's banners in observance of the upcoming holiday season is hereby approved, in accordance with Section 3-42(a)(6) of the Code of the City of Richmond (1986 Supp.). Such banners shall be displayed only in the public right of way along Cary Street, between Thompson Street and the Boulevard, the particular locations within such boundaries to be determined by the City Manager or his designee. The City Manager or his designee shall permit the continued display of the banners for a reasonable time, not to exceed a commencement date of November 15, 1986, and an ending date of December 30, 1986. Any banner displayed during such time shall be and remain in conformity with all of the specifications concerning size, quality of materials, and content, as at the time of acceptance by the City.
