

ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY

The patron request that a resolution be drafted for Council’s consideration supporting the conduct of studies to explore the expansion of the area currently designated as the Jackson Ward Old and Historic District.

Council request that the CAO cause all necessary public hearings and studies be drafted to expand Jackson Ward’s current old and historic district in order to protect and enhance the character of the area by preserving historic structures and regulating development, new construction, building alterations and maintenance, rehabilitations, and demolitions of structures in the greater area known as Jackson Ward.

For purposes of this legislation Jackson area located within North Belvedere Street (east), Interstates 64 and 95 (north), North 3rd Street (west), and the alley between West Marshall Street and West Broad Street (south).
