



1. to identify all risks confronting the city; the department  
2. shall assist all city department, division and bureau heads  
3. to eliminate or reduce risks incidental to the city  
4. departments, divisions or bureaus; the department shall  
5. develop commercial insurance and self-insurance programs to  
6. most effectively and economically protect the city against  
7. losses; and the department shall be responsible for the  
8. education and training of all city employees with regard to  
9. loss prevention and safety technique.

10. § 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect  
11. July 1, 1986.
