PURPOSE: To authorize the City's Chief Administrative Office to accept funds in the amount of \$53,054 from the Department of Criminal Justice Grant and to amend the Commonwealth's Attorney FY2025 Special Fund Budget by appropriating the same for the purpose of increasing the Victim/Witness Services Grant Award.

BACKGROUND: The FY2025 Victim/Witness Services Grant Award to the City was increased by \$53,054; from an anticipated amount of \$704,854 to 757,908. Because the Adopted FY2025 Special Fund Budget (Ordinance #2024-099) appropriated an anticipated amount of \$704,854 the additional \$53,054 of unanticipated grant funds must now be accepted and appropriated.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT: After introduction, the proposed Ordinance will be referred to a future Finance and Economic Development Standing Committee meeting for discussion, where the public is encouraged to attend and provide comments; subsequent to Finance and Economic Development Standing Committee recommendation to City Council, Council to hold a public hearing regarding the proposed Ordinance.
