

AN ORDINANCE No. 86-96-124

ADOPTED MAY 28 1986

To amend and reordain Section 25-9 of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, to establish rates for refuse disposal computed on a basis of twenty dollars per ton in lieu of nineteen dollars per ton and to fix charges for disposal of refuse calculated on rated vehicle capacity contra weighing the materials deposited for disposal.

1. THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:
2. § 1. That Section 25-9 of the Code of the City of
3. Richmond, 1985, be and is hereby amended and reordained as
4. follows:
5. Sec. 25-9. Sanitary transfer stations; charges for
6. refuse disposal by private haulers and
7. governmental units and agencies.
8. (a) City operated sanitary transfer stations shall
9. be available to persons engaged in the disposal of refuse
10. during such hours and upon such conditions as the director
11. may direct.
12. (b) It shall be unlawful for any person or the
13. state, its political subdivisions or agencies or the United
14. States Government, to dispose of refuse at the city transfer
15. stations before weighing the vehicle containing the refuse;
16. except, that persons using an automobile, station wagon,

1. half-ton panel truck or half-ton pickup truck, with a valid
2. city motor vehicle tag, decal or sticker, for the purpose of
3. disposing of refuse at a city transfer station will not be
4. required to pay for disposal of refuse; provided, that the
5. refuse being disposed of was neither collected nor hauled
6. for a fee. In addition, an eleemosynary organization (so
7. designated by the United States Internal Revenue Service for
8. Income Tax purposes), having a headquarters within the city,
9. shall not be required to pay for disposal of refuse at a
10. city transfer station if one of the principal activities of
11. such organization is to collect and haul trash and refuse
12. for recycling and disposal is limited to goods for which
13. recycling is economically unfeasible; provided, however,
14. such eleemosynary organization must not make any charges for
15. collecting and hauling trash and refuse. Anyone collecting
16. or hauling refuse for a fee will be subject to the fee
17. imposed by (c) below; provided however, a civic association,
18. whether incorporated or unincorporated, and comprised
19. entirely of property owners within the corporate limits of
20. the city and specifically within the geographical area
21. making up such association, and which collects leaves, brush
22. and tree trimmings solely for the members of such associa-
23. tion, may dispose of such leaves, brush and tree trimmings
24. at a city operated transfer station without payment of the
25. fee as imposed in subsection (c) of this section.

1. (c) Any person disposing of refuse shall be liable
2. for a charge of [~~nineteen-dollars-(\$19.00)~~] twenty dollars
3. (\$20.00) per ton, computed on the basis of [~~four-dollars~~
4. ~~seventy-five-(\$4.75)~~] five dollars (\$5.00) per each five
5. hundred (500) pounds or a fraction thereof and payable at
6. the time of weighing. Such charge shall be computed to the
7. next highest one dollar (\$1.00). The minimum charge shall
8. be five dollars (\$5.00). Any person exempted from payment
9. of the charge specified for disposal of refuse as provided
10. in (b) above will not be assessed any charges as provided in
11. this paragraph. In lieu of weighing a vehicle prior to and
12. subsequent to disposal of refuse, the city may: (1) with
13. the consent of the hauler, estimate the weight of the load
14. based upon the capacity of the vehicle; or, (2) in lieu of
15. obtaining the consent of the hauler make a charge of ten
16. dollars (\$10.00) for depositing waste from a truck having a
17. rated carrying capacity of one-half ton or less; make a
18. charge of [~~fourteen-dollars-(\$14.00)~~] fifteen dollars
19. (\$15.00) for deposit of waste from a truck having a carrying
20. capacity in excess of one-half ton but no greater than
21. three-fourths ton; make a charge of [~~thirty-eight-dollars-~~
22. ~~(\$38.00)~~] forty dollars (\$40.00) for a truck having a
23. carrying capacity of two (2) tons; make a charge of
24. [~~seventy-six-dollars-(\$76.00)~~] eighty dollars (\$80.00)

1. for a truck having a carrying capacity of two (2) tons or
2. more but less than four (4) tons; and make a charge of [~~one~~
3. ~~hundred-twenty-dollars-(\$120.00)] one hundred twenty-five
4. dollars (\$125.00) for any and all trucks having a rated
5. carrying capacity of four (4) tons or more.~~

6. (d) The director shall promulgate reasonable rules
7. and regulations to permit credit to be established by and
8. extended to persons, firms or corporations, public or
9. private. If five (5) or more vehicles of a specific hauler
10. dispose of materials at a transfer station daily, the
11. director and the hauler may agree for billing on the basis
12. of an average weight per load in lieu of weighing individual
13. vehicles.

14. (e) Passenger car tires, in lots of four (4) or
15. more, may with the approval of the director be disposed of
16. at a transfer station at a charge of fifty cents (\$0.50) per
17. passenger tire. The director may in his discretion author-
18. ize the disposal of tires, other than passenger car tires,
19. at a charge per tire to be negotiated between the director
20. and hauler disposing of same.

21. § 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect July
22. 1, 1986.
