EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION

1. To approve the issuance by the Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority of its multifamily housing revenue bonds in an amount up to \$25,000,000.00 for the acquisition, construction, renovation, rehabilitation and equipping of an approximately 144-unit multifamily residential rental housing project to be known as Chippenham Place Apartments located at 5833 Orcutt Lane in the city of Richmond. (President Jones)

To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, to execute a Standard Project Administration Agreement between the City of Richmond and the Virginia Department of Transportation to provide funding for Route 33 and Martin Luther King Bridge rehabilitation improvements. **{Land Use, Housing and Transportation – May 25, 2023}**

12. To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, to execute a Standard Project Administration Agreement between the City of Richmond and the Virginia Department of Transportation to provide funding for replacement of a culvert over Goodes Creek at Columbia Street and replacement of a bridge over Stony Run and Gillies Creek at East Richmond Road. **{Land Use, Housing and Transportation – May 25, 2023}**
13. To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, to execute a Standard Project Administration Agreement between the City of Richmond and the Virginia Department of Transportation to provide funding for the replacement of a bridge over the Manchester Canal at Hull Street and replacement of a bridge over Gillies Creek at East Richmond Road. **{Land Use, Housing and Transportation – May 25, 2023}**
