

AN ORDINANCE *NO. 87-143-135*  
**ADOPTED JUN 22 1987**

To amend the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, by adding in Chapter 2, Administration, Article V, Boards, Commissions, Committees and Other Agencies, a new division numbered Division 8, entitled: "Advisory Board of Recreation and Parks", consisting of Section 2-250, to create such Advisory Board of Recreation and Parks under the permissive provisions of Section 16.06 of the Charter of the City of Richmond, Chapter 119, Acts of Assembly of 1986.

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That Chapter 2, Administration, of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, be and is hereby amended by adding in Article V, Boards, Commissions, Committees and Other Agencies, thereof a new division, numbered Division 8, entitled: "Advisory Board of Recreation and Parks", consisting of Section 2-250 as follows:

DIVISION 8. ADVISORY BOARD OF RECREATION  
AND PARKS

Sec. 2-250. Created; appointment and terms of office of members.

(a) There shall be an advisory board of recreation and parks to consist of twenty-four (24) members. The persons currently serving as members of the advisory board

shall hold office for the terms for which appointed. The membership shall include one member from the trustees of the Richmond public school system, one member from the planning commission, one member from the board of the Richmond redevelopment and housing authority, one member of the youth service commission, one member of the commission on the elderly, and one member of the mayor's commission on the needs of disabled persons, such members to be appointed for terms coincident with their terms as members of the respective boards or commissions; and eighteen (18) members, two (2) from each of the councilmanic districts of the city, such members to be nominated by members of council from said districts and appointed by council resolution; increase in the number of members from seven (7) to twenty-four (24) shall be made as of September 1, 1987; as any vacancy shall occur by expiration of term or resignation or otherwise of current members or of future appointees, for members other than appointed by a board or commission, a successor shall be nominated by the council member representing the district in which such member resided, unless at such time there are already two (2) or more persons serving as members of the advisory board and then resident in the same district as the person being succeeded resides (unless such person be a board or commission appointee). Other than representatives

appointed by the boards and commissions, members shall be appointed for terms of three (3) years; provided, however, if a council member shall be entitled to nominate two (2) persons simultaneously as representatives of such council member's district other than to complete an unexpired term, one person shall be nominated to serve for a term of two (2) years, and the other for a term of three (3) years. Terms of all members of the advisory board shall expire on the first Tuesday in September in the year in which the term ends, except those persons whose terms run concurrent with terms as their membership of another board or commission.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect as of Tuesday, September 1, 1987.

**SUMMARY**

This Ordinance would amend the Code by adding in Chapter 2, Administration, Article V. Boards, Commissions, Committees and other agencies, a new division numbered Division 8, entitled: Advisory Board of Recreation and Parks.

There shall be 24 members on the Board. Present members shall remain through the terms for which appointed.

**New Membership (24)**

The following six shall be appointed for terms coincident with their terms on respective boards or committees:

- 1 School Board Trustee
  - 1 Planning Commission
  - 1 Richmond Redevelopment & Housing Authority
  - 1 Youth Services Commission
  - 1 Commission on the Elderly
  - 1 Mayor's Commission on Disabled Persons
- 18 Members - 2 from each Councilmanic district.  
These appointees shall be appointed by Council Resolution.
