1 THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

2 SECTION 1. That Section 26-217 of the Code of the
3 City of Richmond, 1985, as follows, be and is hereby
4 repealed:

5 Sec. 26-217. Permits for working and encroaching
6 in streets and alleys - Commercial sign painters.

7 The provisions of Section 26-216 to the
8 contrary, notwithstanding, any person purchasing a license as
9 a commercial sign painter as provided in Section
10 28-444(a) (72) for the purpose of painting residential numbers
11 on curbsides of public streets of the city may purchase a
12 permit entitling him to work in the public streets of the
13 city for such purpose only for a period not to exceed sixty
14 (60) days, the fee for such permit to be two dollars (\$2.00).

1 Sec. 2. This ordinance shall be in force and
2 effect upon adoption.
