WHEREAS, the intersection of Idlewood Avenue and South Harrison Street is located in a populous residential area of the City; and

WHEREAS, it is the consensus of the Council that it would be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Richmond and especially the citizens who reside near the aforesaid intersection to erect all-way stop signs at said intersection; and

WHEREAS, section 2-428 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015), as amended, requires an appropriate study by the Department of Public Works prior to the adoption of an ordinance regulating motor vehicle traffic within the City; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance has been properly referred to the Department of Public Works, and more than 60 days have elapsed since such referral;

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That all-way stop signs shall be erected at the intersection of Idlewood Avenue and South Harrison Street.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption or such other date as may be fixed by traffic order of the Director of Public Works if, prior to adoption, the all-way stop signs have been erected at the aforesaid intersection.

ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY

Patron requests that legislation be drafted for Council's consideration that requires the installation of all-way stop signs at the intersections of Idlewood Avenue and Harrison Street.

BACKGROUND

The Idlewood Avenue and Harrison Street is a busy intersection in between the Randolph and Oregon Hill neighborhoods in the West End. Oregon Hill neighborhood residents, the Randolph Civic Association, along with members of Fifth Baptist Church have expressed concerns about the increase in west bound traffic and intersection safety. Community members have concerns about safety at the intersection and recent near accidents. Community members strongly believe an all way stop will increase safety of the intersection for drivers.
