To amend and reordain Section 7-168 of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, concerning application for and issuance of permits to sidewalk vendors, to provide that any permit issued to a sidewalk vendor during the calendar year 1986 shall expire on April 30, 1987.

1. THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:
2. § 1. That Section 7-168 of the Code of the City of
3. Richmond, 1985, be and is hereby amended and reordained as
4. follows:
5. Sec. 7-168. Same - Application for vendor's permit.
6. A person holding a valid license to do business as a
7. peddler or itinerant merchant in the city may apply to the
8. city for a vendor's permit to be authorized to vend at a
9. specific location on the sidewalk in the central business
10. district. A vendor's permit shall be valid for up to one
11. year from the date of issuance and shall expire on December
12. 31 of the year of issuance; provided, however any permit
13. issued to a sidewalk vendor during the calendar year 1986,
14. in lieu of expiring on December 31, 1986, shall expire on

1. April 30, 1987. Upon application for a vendor's permit the  
2. department of finance shall investigate to determine whether  
3. the requested location meets the criteria of this section.  
4. No location shall be:
- 5. (1) Within one hundred (100) feet of the grounds of  
6. any elementary or secondary school;
  - 7. (2) On a sidewalk that is less than ten (10) feet in  
8. width;
  - 9. (3) More than five (5) or less than one (1) foot from  
10. the curb line of any street;
  - 11. (4) Within fifteen (15) feet of any entranceway to or  
12. exitway from any building;
  - 13. (5) Within five (5) feet of any driveway or inter-  
14. section of any alley with a street;
  - 15. (6) Within five (5) feet of the crosswalk at any  
16. intersection;
  - 17. (7) Within any bus, taxicab or other passenger or  
18. commercial loading zone;
  - 19. (8) Within ten (10) feet of any fire hydrant;
  - 20. (9) Within five (5) feet of any fire escape;
  - 21. (10) Within ten (10) feet of any other location for  
22. which a permit has been issued;
  - 23. (11) On a block face that already contains five (5)  
24. locations designated for vending; or

1.           (12) Situated so that the vending operation will  
2. deny reasonable access to or use of any trash receptacle,  
3. mail box, parking meter or other public facility on the  
4. sidewalk.

5.           § 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon  
6. adoption.

**SUMMARY**

This Ordinance would amend Section 7-158 of the Code of the City of Richmond to provide that any permit issued to a sidewalk vendor during the calendar year 1986 shall expire on April 30, 1987.

Reason: The Sidewalk Vendors Committee is studying the feasibility of standardized carts. The study is expected to be completed by February, 1987, and may require vendors to obtain standardized carts, colors, etc. New permits issued for 1987 may require vendors to comply with new cart regulations.
