MOTION TO AMEND

1. To amend Ord. No. 2016-102, which authorizes the conditional use of the property known as 100 South 14th Street for the purpose of authorizing a nightclub, upon certain terms and conditions, to incorporate revisions to the Southern Railway Taphouse Management Plan.

5. To close, to public use and travel, a portion of North 32nd Street, located south of East Franklin Street and north of Williamsburg Avenue and consisting of 5,418± square feet, upon certain terms and conditions. (Mayor Jones – By Request) **{Planning Commission – May 16, 2016}**
6. To authorize the special use of the property known as 1702 Floyd Avenue for the purpose of permitting one two-family attached dwelling unit and accessory parking, upon certain terms and conditions. (Mayor Jones – By Request) **{Planning Commission – May 16, 2016}**

7. To amend and reordain Ord. No. 80-103-90, adopted Jun. 16, 1980, as previously amended by Ord. No. 2003-26-24, adopted Feb. 10, 2003, and Ord.
