PURPOSE: To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond to accept funds in the amount of \$262,500.00 from the United States Department of Energy, to create a new special fund for the Office of Sustainability in partnership with the Department of Housing and Community Development, the Department of Public Utilities and the Department of Emergency Communications to provide energy efficiency assistance to our low-income residents.

This O&R request also seeks to designate \$250,000.00 of such funds to Viridiant, all for the purpose of providing funding for energy efficiency assistance for low-income residents.

REASON: The City of Richmond's Office of Sustainability is partnering with the Department of Housing and Community Development, the Department of Public Utilities, and the Department of Emergency Communications to provide energy efficiency assistance to our low-income residents in alignment with on-going programs prioritizing home safety, lead pipe removal, and flood resilience. Viridiant, a local non-profit that provides community energy services, will bring the necessary energy expertise to perform home energy audits, install energy saving fixtures, and identify energy efficiency opportunities and incentives tailored to each homeowner.

RECOMMENDATION: City Council approves the \$262,500.00 from the DOE Energy Block Conservation Grant Program to create a new special fund to assist low-income households with energy efficiency measures by providing services to approximately 100 homes.

BACKGROUND: The City of Richmond's Office of Sustainability will be partnering with the Department of Housing and Community Development, the Department of Public Utilities, and the Department of Emergency Communications to provide energy efficiency assistance to our low-income residents in alignment with ongoing programs prioritizing home safety, lead pipe removal, and flood resilience. Viridiant, a local non-profit that provides community energy services, will bring the necessary energy expertise to perform home energy audits, install energy saving fixtures, and identify energy efficiency opportunities and incentives tailored to each homeowner. The proposed project will utilize the \$262,500.00 of formula grant funds allocated to the City of Richmond through the DOE Energy Block Conservation Grant Program to assist low-income households with energy efficiency measures, by providing services to approximately 100 homes. These services will be provided to the same

households receiving repairs through HCD's Healthy Homes program; additional services will also be extended to a number of wait-listed or ineligible applicants. This 2-year program will greatly reduce energy burden and provide immediate financial savings for residents in Richmond's disadvantaged communities. EECBG funding will allow the City to progress towards meeting its energy efficiency and equity goals, as outlined in RVAGreen2050, and offer an opportunity to strengthen partnerships and grow future energy assistance programs.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT: The City of Richmond has been conducting equity-based community engagement throughout the RVAGreen 2050 planning process, which has been continuously informed by the Racial Equity & Environmental Justice Roundtable (11 community members from communities on the frontlines of climate change who received stipends to represent their lived experiences and vet every step of the planning process). During this process, the Richmond community identified residential energy burden as a top priority. EECBG funds will allow the City to advance its energy efficiency and equity goals, while also specifically addressing strategy BE 2.1 in RVAGreen 2050; reducing residential energy burden for Richmond's most vulnerable communities and improving residential resilience to climate change. Facilitating and implementing energy efficiency upgrades for Richmond's low-income residents will reduce inequitable energy costs, improve quality of life for residents, and reduce greenhouse gas emissions. Outreach and education will complement this initiative and will include climate education and program promotion. Climate education will include distribution of printed materials to program participants and other project stakeholders (energy audit reports, relative incentives, emergency response materials for heat vulnerability and flooding, RVAGreen climate plan navigator), as well as conducting three community workshops in project neighborhoods and completing an electrification benefits case study for use in outreach. The outreach and education component is part of the residential energy burden strategy in RVAGreen 2050 (BE 2.1), and is a necessary link to expanding energy efficiency programs for our low-income communities in the future.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no local match required. The department of OOS does not anticipate any impact to the city's budget for this or future fiscal years related to activities associated with this grant.

GRANT CONTRACT

THIS GRANT CONTRACT is made this between the City of Richmond, a municipal corporation and political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Virginia (the "City"), and Viridiant, a Virginia non-stock corporation (the "Recipient").

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

- A. Section 15.2-953(B) Code of Virginia authorizes the City to make gifts and donations to any nonprofit association or organization furnishing services to beautify and maintain communities or to prevent neighborhood deterioration.
- B. By Ordinance No. funds in the amount of \$250,000.00 (the "Grant Funds") derived from a portion of the City's allocation of the United States Department of Energy, (DOE) Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) allocation shall be appropriated for a gift to the Recipient in the City's 2024 Fiscal Year Non-Departmental Budget.
- C. Section 12-15 of the Code of the City of Richmond requires the Recipient to enter into a grant contract with the City prior to the City's disbursement of the Grant Funds to the Recipient.

The City and the Recipient, intending to be legally bound, agree as follows:

C. Either party may change the contact information set forth in this section by submitting a written statement that the party is making such a change and setting forth the contact information of the party's new point of contact to the other party's point of contact.

2. Payment of Grant Funds.

- A. The City shall pay the Grant Funds to the Recipient in one lump sum following full execution of this Agreement.
- 3. **Scope of Services**. In consideration of the City's grant of the Grant Funds to the Recipient shall:
 - A. Manage/conduct Energy Audits. Test-In Energy Audits: Identify and prioritize opportunities to maximize energy burden reductions obtained by funded repairs. Test-Out Energy Audits: Examine for quality assurance, safety, and calculations of energy savings achieved.
 - B. Direct-Install Energy Conservation Measures: As appropriate to include LED lightbulbs, hot water pipe insulation, low-flow aerators and showerheads, central HVAC air filters, weatherstripping and insulation of attic access points, basic duct sealing, and re-insulation of HVAC refrigerant lines.
 - C. Energy Education: Conduct residential energy efficiency education in conjunction with the Office of Sustainability to promote energy efficiency in alignment with RVAgreen program goals.
 - D. Project Coordination: Oversee project staff and collaborate with project team

and grant partners.

- E. Reporting: Develop procedures for ongoing residential energy efficiency project implementation, track energy and carbon reductions as well as clean energy benefits resulting from these residential retrofits.
- 4. **Performance Measures**. The City will use the following performance measure to evaluate whether the Recipient has performed the services required by this Contract in a manner that achieves the City's purpose in providing the Grant Funds to the Recipient:
 - A. Recipient will administer the Fund in accordance with the Scope of Services set forth in Section 3 of this Agreement?

5. **Reporting**. Recipient shall:

- A. Maintain detailed records regarding all expenditures pertaining to the Grant.
- B. Provide quarterly reports regarding the status of each activity included within the Scope of Services: Not Started, Completed less than 50 percent, Completed 50 percent or more, or completed. The recipient shall also provide a narrative description of each activity included in the Scope of Services. The Recipient shall include in each narrative description:
 - 1. Anecdotal evidence, stories, or testimony pertaining to each activity, including any appropriate pictures, videos or other media content.
 - 2. Key performance indicators identified by the Recipient and any mandated performance indicators identified by United States Department of Energy, together with reporting on how the Recipient plans to ensure that projected outcomes are achieved in an effective, efficient, and equitable manner.
- C. Complete any additional forms or reports and provide any additional information that may be reasonably required by the City throughout the term of this Contract,.
- D. Maintain all books, records, and other documents relating to this Contract for 3 years following expiration of this Contract.

6. Release, Indemnity, and Insurance.

6.1 **Release.** The City shall not be liable for any personal injury or property damage to Recipient or its agents, contractors, employees, invitees, licensees, officers, or volunteers irrespective of how the injury or damage is caused, and Recipient hereby releases the City

from any liability, real or alleged, for any personal injury or property damage to Recipient or its agents, contractors, employees, invitees, licensees, officers, or volunteers irrespective of how the injury or damage is caused. Nothing herein shall be construed as a waiver of the sovereign immunity granted to the City by the Commonwealth of Virginia statutes and case law to the extent that it applies. This section 6.1 will survive expiration of this Contract.

- Indemnity. Recipient shall indemnify and defend the City and its agents, contractors, employees, officers, and volunteers from and against any and all losses, liabilities, claims, damages and expenses, including court costs and reasonable attorneys' fees, caused by, resulting from, or arising out of any claim, action, or other proceeding, including any claim, action or other proceeding that is based on, arising out of, or related to (i) Recipient's breach of this Contract, (ii) the performance of any activities under this Contract; (iii) the conduct or actions of Recipient or its agents, contractors, employees, invitees, licensees, officers, or volunteers within or outside the scope of this Contract, or (iv) any error, omission, negligent act or intentional act of Recipient or its agents, contractors, employees, invitees, licensees, officers, or volunteers. This section 6.2 will survive expiration of this Contract.
- 6.3 **Insurance.** The Recipient shall ensure that commercial general liability insurance with a combined limit of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence, insuring the Recipient and any of its agents, contractors, employees, invitees, licensees, officers, or volunteers performing services on behalf of the Recipient pursuant to this Contract, with an insurer licensed to transact insurance business in the Commonwealth of Virginia is maintained throughout the duration of this Contract. The insurance policy or policies under which the required insurance is provided shall list the City as an additional insured and shall be effective before the Recipient or its agents, contractors, employees, invitees, licensees, officers, or volunteers perform any activities contemplated by this Contract. The Recipient shall furnish the City with copies of the required additional insured endorsements and such certificates of insurance evidencing the existence of the required insurance coverage as the City may request.
- 8. **Acknowledgement of Donation.** The Recipient shall, in connection with any programs, events, or other matters funded in whole or in part with the Grant Funds, acknowledge the City of Richmond and the Department of Energy, as a donor, contributor, or sponsor. This acknowledgement must be included on any promotional materials, brochures, publications, websites, or other visible locations. The City has the right, upon request, to review and approve any such acknowledgement. Further, the City has the right, in its sole discretion, to require the removal of its name from any such promotional materials, brochures, publications, websites, or other visible locations.
- 9. **Compliance Monitoring.** The City's point of contact shall monitor the Recipient's compliance with this Contract. In addition to the reports required by Section 5, the Recipient shall furnish the City's point of contact with any information reasonably requested by the City's point of contact in order to enable the City's point of contact to

determine whether the Recipient is meeting or has met the performance measures set forth in this Contract.

- 10. Recipient's Representations and Warranties. The Recipient represents and warrants as follows:
 - The Recipient is and will be for the duration of this Contract a charitable A. institution or association as detailed in Section 15.2-953(B) of the Code of Virginia.
 - The Recipient's signatory below is duly authorized by the Recipient to enter into В. this Contract and thereby bind the Recipient to this Contract's terms and conditions. This Contract is signed when a party's signature is delivered by facsimile, email, or another electronic medium. These signatures must be treated in all respects as having the same force and effect as original signatures.
- 11. Audit. Pursuant to Section 2-187 of the Code of the City of Richmond, the Recipient shall, as a condition of receiving monies from the City, be subject to periodic audits of its finances and expenditures of such City monies by the City Auditor on demand and without notice. The Recipient further agrees to any audits as may be required in connection with DOE funding and agrees to fully cooperate with the City in connection with any such audits.
- 12. Contract Expiration. This Contract will expire on June 08, 2026 unless both parties agree to extend the Contract.
