#### **BACKGROUND**

Councilmembers Lambert and Lynch have requested to no longer serve on the Plan RVA Commission. This resolution seeks to respect that request and remove them from membership.

• Either one of the alternates can substitute for either regular member. If the alternate is the only member present, the member would cast four votes.
