§ 1. That the Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to accept grant funds in the amount of \$716,000 from the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality for the purpose of funding the Goode's Creek Stream Restoration & Constructed Wetlands project.

§ 2. That the funds received from the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality are hereby appropriated to the Capital Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2016, and ending June 30, 2017, by increasing estimated revenues by \$716,000, increasing the amount appropriated for expenditures by \$716,000 and allotting to the Department of Public Utilities'

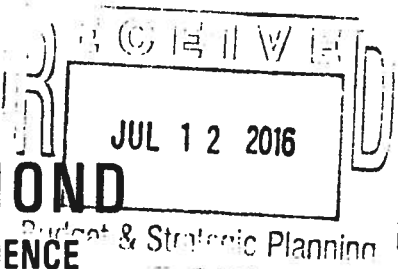

PURPOSE: To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer to accept funds in the amount of \$716,000 from the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality in the form of a matching grant pursuant to the conditions set forth in the attached "Stormwater Local Assistance Fund (SLAF) FY 2015" letter from the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality dated December 17, 2014 and to appropriate the increase to the Fiscal Year 2017 Capital Budget by increasing estimated revenues and the amount appropriated to the Stormwater Construction Fund by \$716,000 for the purpose of constructing the Goode's Creek Stream Restoration & Constructed Wetlands Project.

REASON: The Department of Public Utilities will utilize the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality Stormwater Local Assistance Fund (SLAF) matching grant to help fund The City's proposed Goode's Creek Stream Restoration & Constructed Wetlands Project. This stream

restoration project is being constructed as part of the City's efforts to satisfy Chesapeake Bay TMDL (Total Maximum Daily Load) requirements.

RECOMMENDATION: The City Administration recommends adoption of this Ordinance.

BACKGROUND: The Department of Public Utilities in December 2014 secured approval for a Virginia Department of Environmental Quality Stormwater Local Assistance Fund (SLAF) matching grant to help fund the City's proposed Goode's Creek Stream Restoration & Constructed Wetlands Project. This stream restoration project is being constructed as part of The City's efforts to satisfy Chesapeake Bay TMDL (Total Maximum Daily Load) requirements as mandated by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the City of Richmond's Municipal Separate Storm Sewer (MS4) permit (General Permit No.: VAR040005) issued by the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality. The Chesapeake Bay TMDL establishes pollution reduction goals for phosphorus, nitrogen and sediment for municipalities located within the Chesapeake Bay watershed in an effort to improve water quality in the bay and the region's streams, creeks and rivers.

FISCAL IMPACT/ COST: The City will receive additional revenue of \$716,000 in the form of a Stormwater Local Assistance Fund matching grant from the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality in support of the Goode's Creek Stream Restoration & Constructed Wetlands Project. The City's Stormwater Utility will contribute \$716,000 in matching funds for the project.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS: The Department of Public Utilities will utilize the total funding package of \$1,432,000 during calendar years 2016 & 2017 for the completion of the project.
