THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That Section 9-328 of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, be and is hereby amended and reordained as follows:

Sec. 9-328. Use of public grounds, etc.; fee for use of Dogwood Dell Amphitheater and the Carillon in Byrd Park.

(a) A fee of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) shall be charged and paid into the city treasury for the use of the Dogwood Dell Amphitheater in Byrd Park for programs other than festival of arts productions staged under the joint auspices of the department of recreation and parks, programs for which said fee is to be imposed to include graduation ceremonies, orientations, and sponsored performances and productions (other than festival of arts). The person, firm, corporation, or other entity to whom the Dogwood Dell Amphitheater is rented shall not charge admission for any such performance or activity.

(b) A fee of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each three day use shall be charged and paid into the city treasury for the use of the Carillon in Byrd Park.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect July 1, 1987.
